DETAILS OF WORK

It has been established through packer tests that communication exists between perforations at 3548-58 and perforations at 3694-3702 behind the 5 1/2" casing. It is proposed to repair this by setting a bridge plug at 3610' and squeezing 75 sacks below a retrievable retainer set at about 3450'. This is a water injection well.
