DETAILS OF WORK

On April 2, 1964, after setting a magnesium bridge plug at 3610', a retrievable retainer was set at 3450'. 75 sacks of cement were squeezed below retainer with a maximum pressure of 3,000 psi. Cement top was left at 3450'. Cement has been drilled out and well is cleaned out to a depth of 3965'. Injection of water has been resumed.
