This well is presently a water injection well but has reached the point where it is taking only a small amount of water. In September 1976, it took one barrel of water per day at 1850 psi., and took no water in October. The well was previously fraced and acidized, so no remedial work seems appropriate. It is proposed to convert the well to a producing well to produce from perforations at 3776-3802 and 3838-3848'.

Instructions
