- Moved in and rigged up workover rig August 31, 1970, pulled rods.
 - Tagged bottom with tubing, found no fill, pulled tubing.
 - Reran tubing open-ended. Spotted 500 gallons 15% "NK" acid over open hole, 3850-3981'. Washed formation and displaced acid. Pulled tubing.
 - Ran 2-3/8" OD tubing internally lined with Rice Engineering's Dupline with Halliburton R-4 tension packer set at 3789'.
 - Filled casing annulus behind tubing with water treated with inhibitors.
 - Well converted to injection on September 24, 1970, and shut in waiting on lines. Water will be injected into open-hole section 3850-3981' of the San Andres Formation.

This is a water injection well for the Lea "D" lease operated by Skelly Oil Company.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
