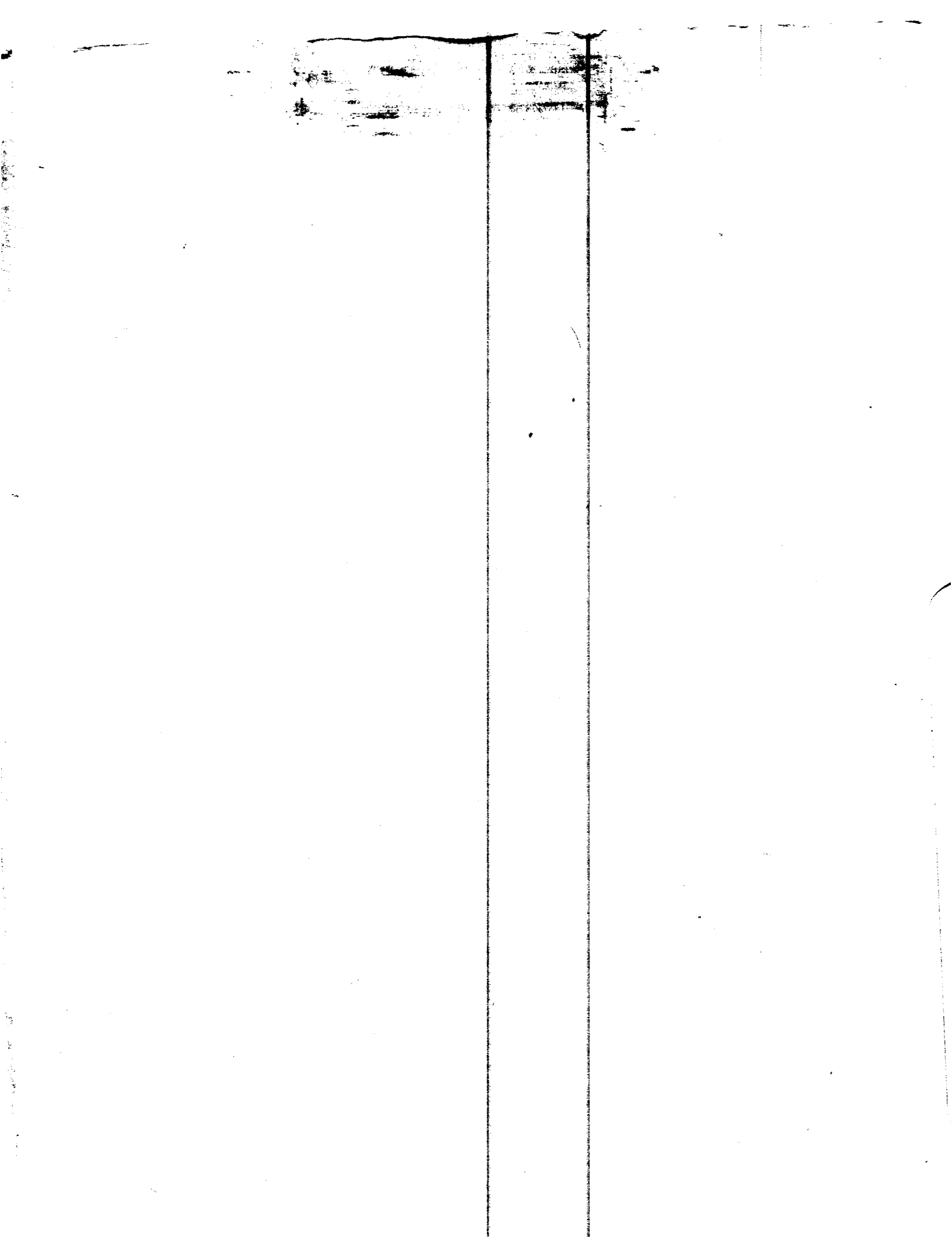

- 2) Set 4½ C.I.B.P. at 6900' cap w/35' cement
- 3) Load hole w/mud
- 4) Spot 100' cement plug at 3800'
- 5) Spot 100' cement plug at 1650' w.o.c. tag cement top at 1480'
- 6) Perforate 4½ casing at 1350' unable to pump into perforations
Perforate 4½ casing at 1200' unable to pump into perforations
Perforate 4½ casing at 362' at 13 3/8 shoe, was able to pump into perforations but did not load
- 7) Spot 10 sxs cement plug at 1350'
- 8) Spot 25 sxs cement at 400' inside 4½ casing and pump 75 sxs cement between 4½ and 8 5/8 w.o.c. did not tag cement. Respot cement plug at 400' w/30 sxs cement w.o.c. tag cement top at 362' pump 75 sxs cement between 4½ and 8 5/8 casing w.o.c. tag cement inside 4½ casing at 335'
- 9) Spot 150 sxs cement between 4½ and 8 5/8 to surface and spot cement from 335' to surface inside 4½ casing set p and a marker.
