Dear Mose:

We have a copy of Form C-110 on the Sinclair Oil and Gas Company Turner B-SP No. 48 C, 29-17-31, which does not show a gas transporter nor does it show the present disposition of the gas. Form C-110 was revised July 1st, 1955, so that both the oil and gas transporters could be shown on the form, and in the event there was no gas connection, the operator could show what is being done with the gas. In the future, please return the forms which do not show this information to the operator so that they can be completed before approval.

We notice also that on Form C-104 on this same well the date first new oil was run to tanks was not shown. This is the date which establishes the date of first allowable and no Form C-104 should be approved unless it is shown.

I don't think you will have much difficulty in getting this information on the forms when the operators learn that their forms will not be approved without it.
