## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

This well was shot with 100 - quarts of Nitro Glycerin from 1,96 to 2,044 feet in hard sandy lime formation - with 4" shell - approximately with 2.5 quarts of Nitro Glycerin per foot. Well was cleaned out to total depth of 2,054 feet and completed for 25 - barrels of oil per day. Increase was from 10 to 25 barrels.
