We will land approximately 375' of 3 5/8" casing, and drill completely through any pay encountered, to a depth not to exceed 4,000 feet. We will pull 3 5/8" casing and set 5 1/2" casing and cement with not less than 1200 sacks cement and circulate the cement to the surface. The well will be completed through perforations.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

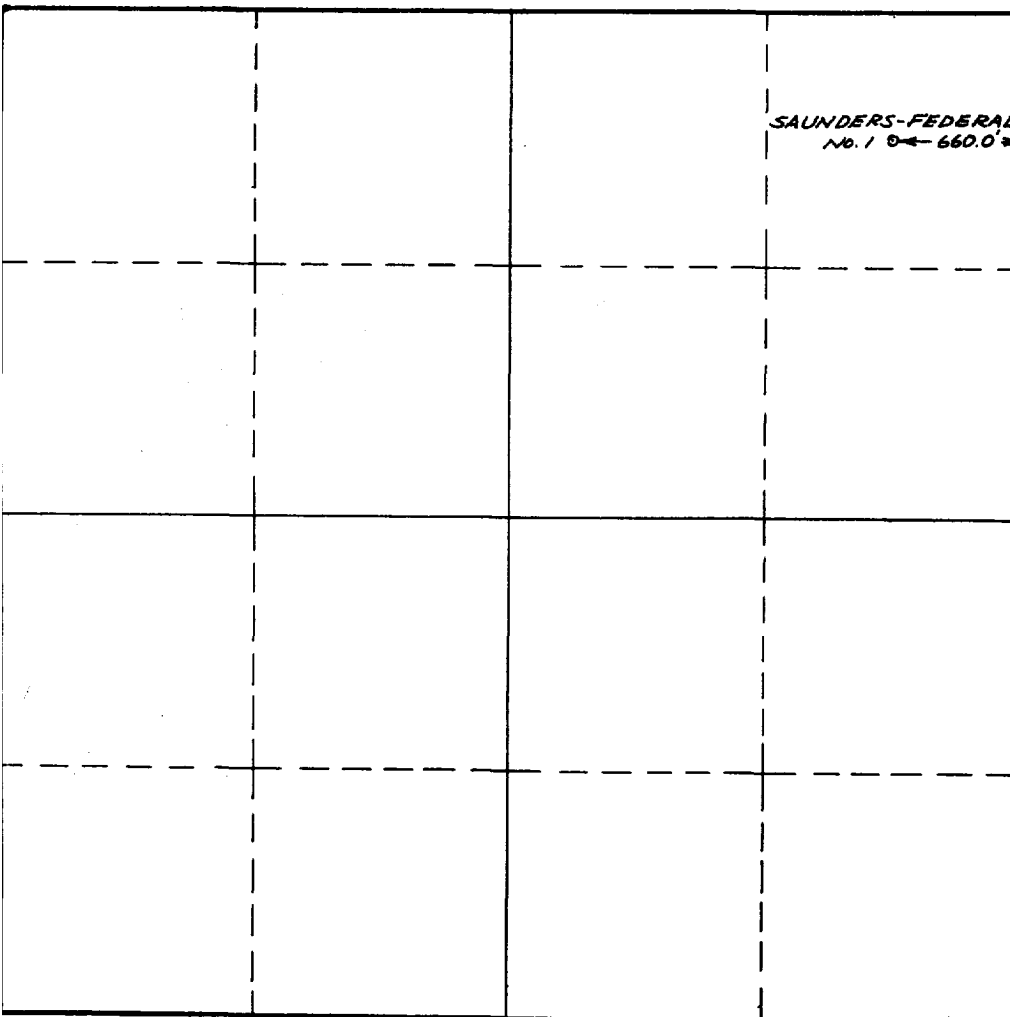
