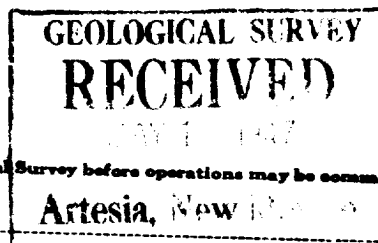

DETAILS OF WORK

This well was plugged and abandoned 3-20-47 as outlined in our Notice Of Intention To Abandon Well, 1600 feet of 7" casing was recovered from the well before plugging. On completion of the plugging operation, the abandoned well was marked with a 4" pipe extending 4' above ground and set in a 5 sack cement plug. The lease was cleaned up and restored to its original condition.
