FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

Propose to pull approximately 316 feet of 8-1/4" surface casing and 2427' oil string (7" O.D.). Plan to set 10 sax cement in bottom of hole (3694' TD), mud back to bottom of salt at 900 feet and set 10 sax cement, mud to top of salt (420') and set 10 sax cement, mud to top and set regulation marker with five sax cement at top.
