Gentlemen:

About one week ago the above captioned well, located in Unit L in Section 7 of 185-27E was re-fraced. During the past week we have been recovering load oil. Saturday evening at about 6:00 P.M., an oil trucked owned by C. L. East was hauling frac oil from this location. At approximately 6:00 P.M., the truck backfired and set oil on fire that had dripped from the end of the hose. The driver was unable to control the blaze and it destroyed the tractor and trailer. The fire in the frac tank was extinguished. From gauges it appears that 114 barrels of oil were lost. No damage was done to the well, tank battery or other surface installations.
