SUPPLEMENT TO THE OIL PRODUCTION SCHEDULE

For the purpose of the Oil Conservation Commission, the following schedule is hereby established:

1. The production of oil shall be limited to the amount of oil which can be produced in the State of New Mexico, without the use of artificial means, and without the use of any other method than the natural flow of the oil.
