In plugging the hole, 20 sacks of cement were used from 2594' to 2555'; mud from 2555' to 790'; 10 sack of cement from 790' to 760'; mud from 760' to 320'; cement from 320' to 295'; mud from 295' to top, with 4 feet of 4" pipe above surface as marker.
