Gentlemen:

This letter will acknowledge receipt of your Form C-104, Request for Oil Allowable, and Form C-110, Certificate of Compliance and Authorization to Transport Oil for the above captioned well.

It has come to the Commission's attention that this well was originally a water well and was drilled deeper and completed for production of oil and gas some years ago and happens to be an unorthodox location. The Santa Fe office of the Commission advises that it will be necessary for you to submit Form C-128, Well Location Plat, in triplicate showing the footage location of said well in the section and also a plat showing all offset oil and gas lease owners and royalty owners. Submit all plats in triplicate to the Artesia office of the Commission.

The Commission will consider the matter of assigning the allowable to this well after receiving the information request in the above paragraph.
