The wells you were asking about are now Western Drilling Co., Inc. Wells. Wells # 1 and 2 were drilled by Bassett and Birney; Well 3 was drilled by Jones and Watkins. Well # 1-A is the only well that they have reported having any gas connection, and the transporter is Phillips Petroleum Co.
