NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ABANDON WELL

Notice must be given at least five days before work is to begin to the State Geologist or to the proper Oil and Gas Inspector. It is desirable that a representative of the Department of the State Geologist witness the plugging of wells being abandoned whenever possible. If changes in the proposed plan are considered advisable, a copy of this notice showing such changes will be returned to the sender. Submit this notice in duplicate.

You are hereby notified that it is our intention to abandon Winans No. 1. Well
No. One in N. 4. of Sec. 15 of Sec. 18S, T. 26E.,
N. M. P. M., Artesia Oil Field, Eddy County.
We plan to commence work on February, 6, 19 28.

The reasons for wishing to abandon the well are as follows:

The work which we propose to do in abandoning the well is as follows:

filled hole with heavy mud laden fluid from bottom of
hole to 1600 feet, put five foot dry wooden plug at 1600.
filled hole with heavy mud laden fluid to 1225, put five foot
dry wooden plug at 1225.
filled hole with heavy mud laden fluid from 1225 to 1135, and
put salt water packer at 1135 in the rock, and another packer
at 1125 feet, put five foot dry wooden plugs, and mudded to 6'
and set lead plug, and mud laden fluid to top, water entirely c
