As there was no 6 5/8 inch casing in this well, the hole was first filled with several hundred feet of heavy mud. In endeavoring to start the $8\frac{1}{4}$ inch casing it was parted at about 70 feet. The pipe was then set back down and the hole completely filled with mud up to 70 feet from the surface. After pulling the casing the remaining hole was filled and a regulation marker erected. Plugging commenced February 8, 1932 and completed February 15,
