The above captioned well was drilled as a replacement well for McNutt State No. 12 which was drilled as an injection well in Artesia Pilot Flood No. 2, but was junked by the contractor and subsequently was plugged and abandoned.

Prior to the junking and plugging, No. 12 was approved as an injection well by the Oil Conservation Commission by its Administrative Order WFX No. 19.

Well No. 17 was drilled as a replacement well for No. 12 and is located 1685' from South line and 955' from West line of Section 21, T 18 S, R 28 E, and is located more than 330' from the nearest forty-acre unit line and more than 660' from any well and, thus, is an orthodox location.

This well is completed for water injection and has cement lined tubing set at approximately 1900' with a packer with injection to be through tubing as set out in the order.
