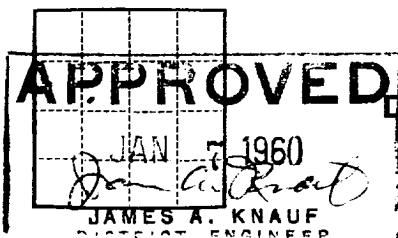

DETAILS OF WORK

ARTESIA, OFFICE

Propose to drill well to Queen Sand, expected to be found at 2040' to 2200'. Propose to set 8 5/8", 2 1/2' surface casing at 340' and cement to surface. Propose to set 4 1/2", 9 1/2' production casing at 2200' and cement to 1600' outside the casing. Propose to perforate the 4 1/2" casing opposite the Queen Sand. Propose to use well as a water injection well for a pilot water flood project.
