On August 1, 1963, perforations at 4307-30 were acidized with 500 gallons 15% acid. Well tested 12 BOPD by swabbing after acid. On August 2, re-acidized with 1500 gallons 15% acid. After swabbing load fluid, well flowed 66 barrels of oil per day through open 2".
