to Rule 303 (a)

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter dated March 20, 1964, wherein you request temporary authority to commingle production from the Loco Hills Grayburg-San Andres and the Artesia Queen-Grayburg-San Andres Pools underlying your Dunn "A" and Dunn "B" Leases in Section 7, Township 18 South, Range 29 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. It is our understanding that this request results from the pool boundary separating the Artesia and Loco Hills Pools running through your lease, and that a nomenclature case is pending whereby it is proposed that the W/2 of Section 7 will be deleted from the Loco Hills Pool and the Artesia Pool extended to include said acreage.

Your request for temporary authority to commingle the production from the two aforesaid pools is hereby granted.
