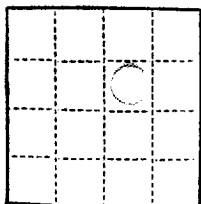

** Install scratchers & centralizers over prospective pays & externally clean casing, same intervals. Cement with 350 sks. Class "C" neat containing 10% salt by weight of mixing water. Use good fresh water. Should cover to base of salt

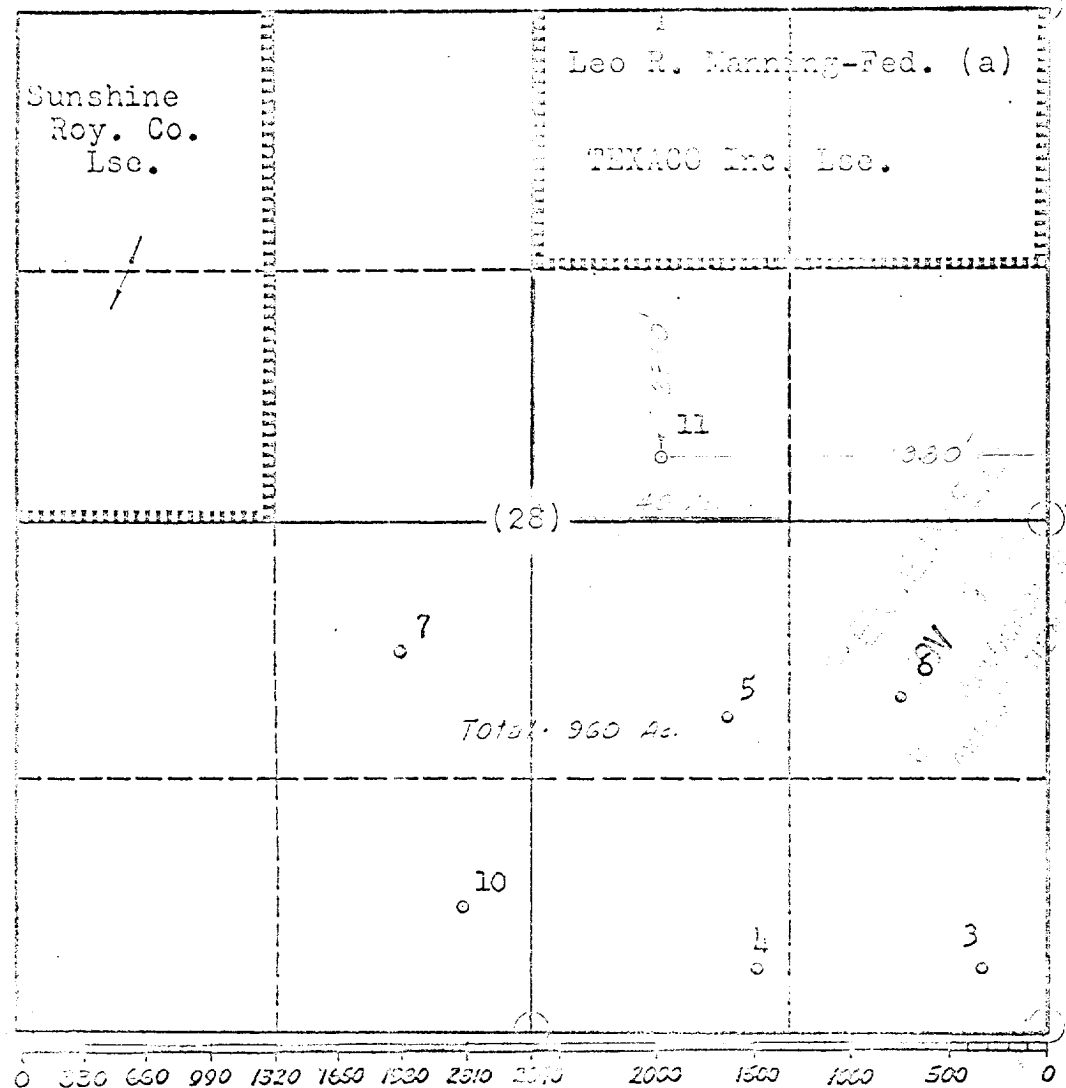
