Spudded well 7:00 P.M. CST, September 24, 1963. Drilled 9-7/8" hole to depth of 1120'. Run and cemented 7", 20#/ft., J-55, STBC, new casing at 1107.53' with 900 sk cement. Circulated estimated 100 sk cement to surface. W.O.C. 8:30 P.M. CST, After W.O.C. 18 hours, rigged up blow-out preventer equipment. Tested 7" casing & BOP to 1000 psi for 30 minutes, O.K. Drilled out from under plug. Tested formation and casing shoe to 600 psi, O.K. Now drilling ahead in 6 1/2" hole at 1379'.
