Your Notice of Intention to Drill well No. 1 LBY (copy attached) in the NE1/4, sec. 26, T. 18 S., R. 23 E., N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico to a depth of 1,500 feet to test the San Andres formation is hereby approved subject to compliance with the provisions of the Oil and Gas Operating Regulations and subject to the following conditions:

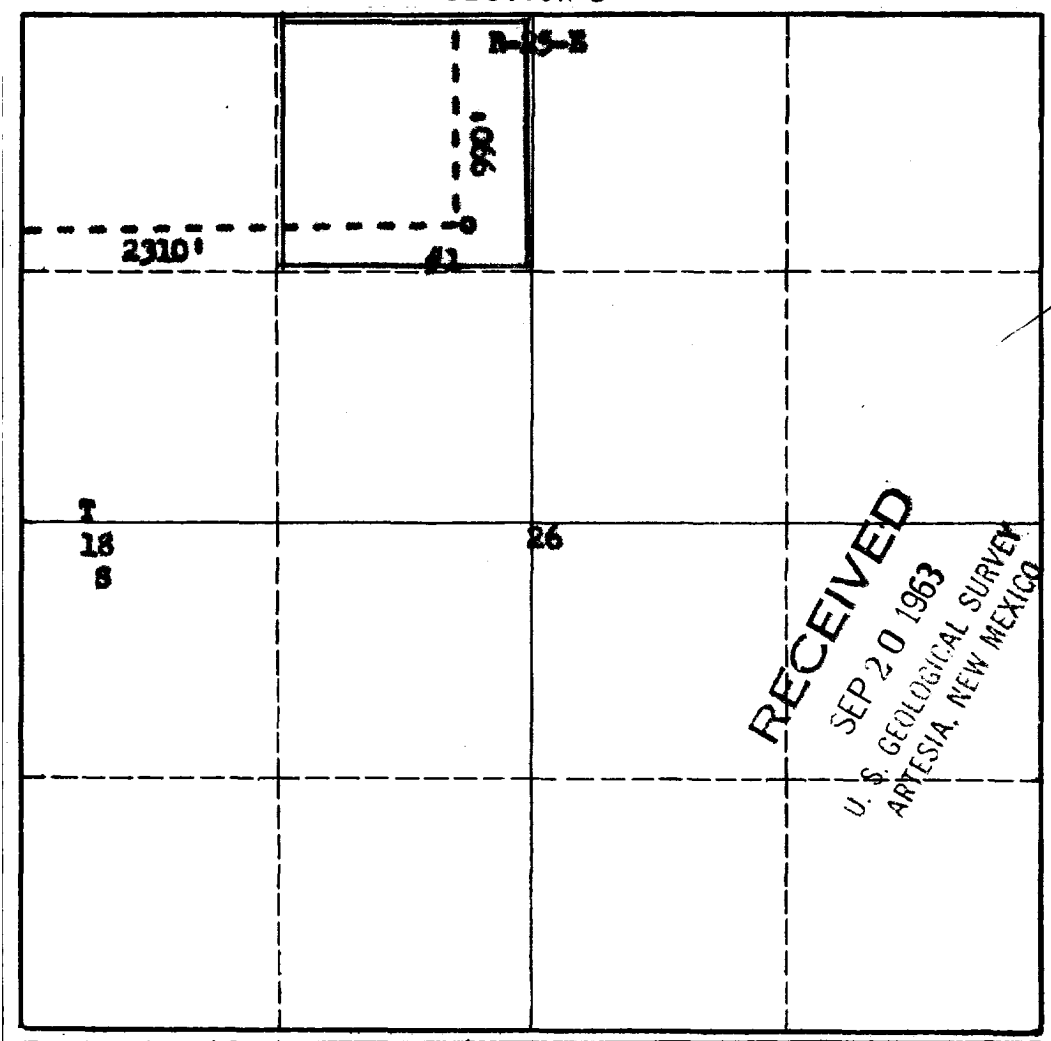
