Dear Sir:

This is in reference to the attached Sundry Notice entitled "Future Plans" for your well No. 1 LBY, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. 26, T. 18 S., R. 25 E., Eddy County, New Mexico.

This well is located within the Roswell-Artesian Water Basin and therefore, it is required that the water protection casing be cemented from total depth back to the surface. On September 1 and 2, 1965, the water protection string ($4\frac{1}{2}$ -inch casing) was set at a depth of 1,725 feet and cemented, with the top of the cement located at approximately 855 feet from the surface. At that time this office granted approval to postpone the required corrective work until November 1, 1965, in order for you to test the well. On about November 1, 1965 this office again granted approval to postpone the corrective work for another 60 days, until January 1, 1966, in order for you to further test this well. To this date the required corrective work has not yet commenced.

Therefore, your attached Sundry Notice is hereby approved, provided that the required corrective work on the $4\frac{1}{2}$ -inch casing must commence within 15 days from the receipt of this letter.

Kindly contact this office prior to commencing any work on this well in order that an engineer from this office may witness all operations.

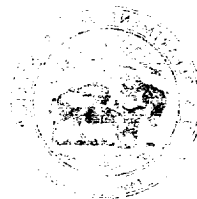
