Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of August 19, 1963, wherein you request permission to complete your Adkins Williams Well No. 7 located in the SW/4 SE/4 SE/4 of Section 17, Township 18 South, Range 28 East, Eddy County, New Mexico, in a different manner than that reflected by the record of Case No. 2712.

The method requested and hereby approved will consist of the following:

1. One string of 4 1/2 inch O.D. pipe set to a total depth of 2463' and cemented from the bottom with 150 sacks of cement.
2. A second stage of cement on the 4 1/2 inch pipe from 354 feet through the water zone if possible.
3. If unable to cement through the water zone at approximately 290 feet to 300 feet, then the hole shall be bridged and cement pumped behind the casing and above the water zone from the surface.

This method of completion is approved for this well only and shall not be construed as applying to other wells in this area.
