On July 30, 1975, perforations at 3695-3718 and 3927-51 were shut off by setting a bridge plug at 3645' with 5' of cement on top. 5½" casing was then perforated at 3538-50 with 2 shots per foot. On Sept. 15, 1975, acidized with 500 gallons 15% N.E. acid. Treated at 2600 psi. maximum at 4 BPM. On Sept. 22, 1975 well pumped 1 BO + 4 BWP.

Instructions
