USGS Form 9-331 was submitted 9-7-64 indicating well was to be held for possible use in proposed waterflood operation. The North Benson Queen Unit was formed during 1974 but this well was not included in the unit. Since well is a direct offset, we would like to leave in a temporarily abandon status until it can be determined what affect waterflood will have on this well.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
