RE: Deliverability Tests
Hope Strawn Gas
Eddy County, New Mexico

Gentlemen:

Sunray DX Oil Company is presently evaluating the economics of constructing approximately 15.5 miles of gathering line necessary to connect three shut-in gas wells to a sales line. The subject wells and locations are as follows:

Hope Unit No. 1	Unit J of Section 19, T-18-S, R-23-E
South Hope Unit No. 1	Unit K of Section 30, T-18-S, R-23-E
South Hope Unit No. 2	Unit A of Section 36, T-18-S, R-21-E

A cost of approximately \$167,000 is estimated to purchase and install the gathering line and necessary surface equipment to produce the wells.

Sunray DX Oil Company therefore respectfully requests permission to conduct deliverability tests of a maximum of 7 days duration on each of the two wells. The tests will be conducted as per the attached outline and a maximum of 28 MMCF of gas will be vented.

These tests are necessary to accurately determine the reserves of the reservoir and predict its future performance. An accurate determination of these factors is required to evaluate the feasibility of installing the system.
