We propose drilling a hole to approximately 9000 feet or to sufficient depth to test the Upper Wolfcamp formation. Our plan is to drill to approximately 8000 feet with water and mud up at this depth. A drillstem test will be run to test the Upper Wolfcamp. If this formation appears capable of commercial production, 4 1/2 inch production casing will be run to total depth.

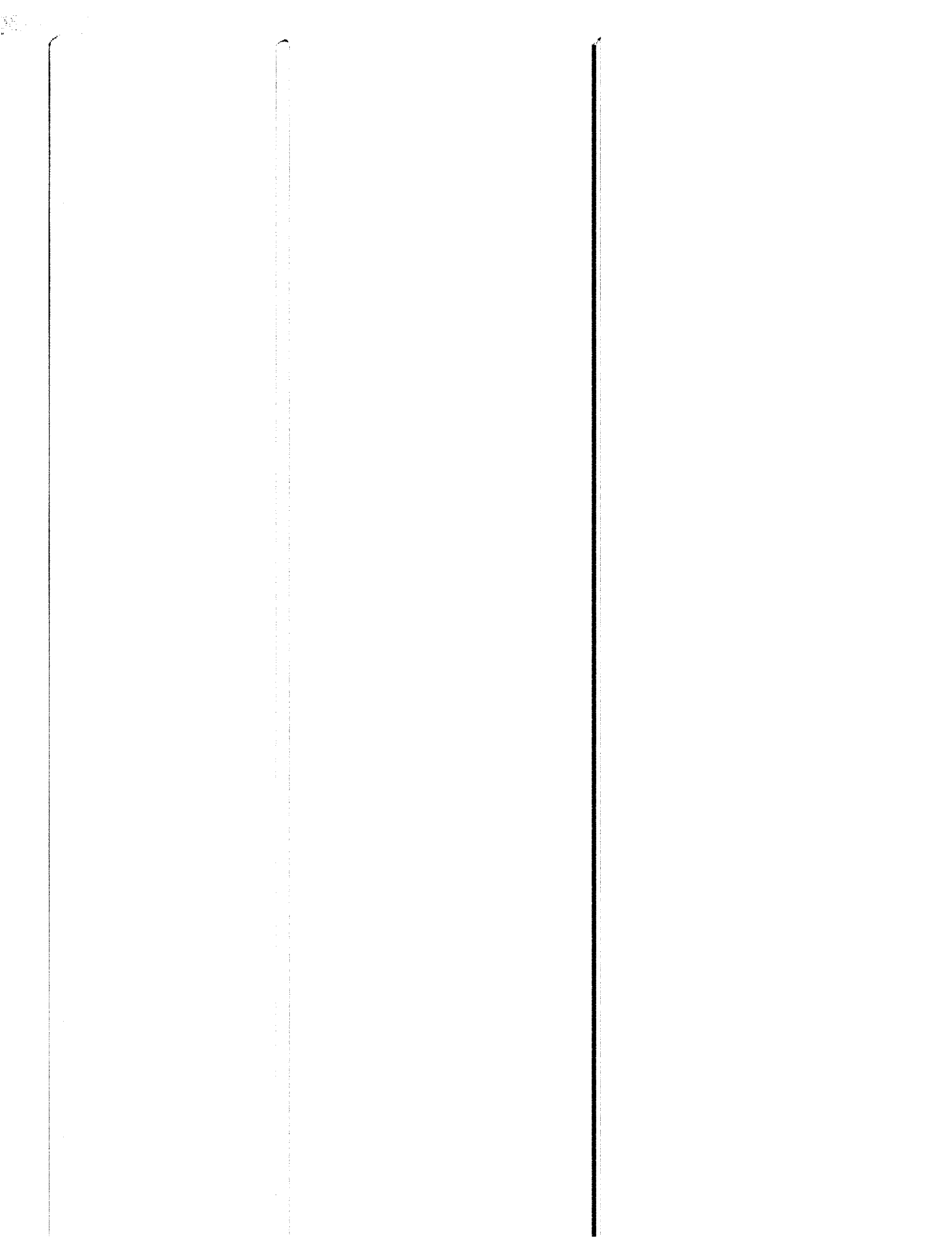

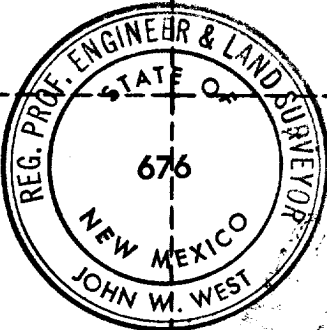
