November 8, 1965 - Set the following cement plugs:

1. Set 35 sack cement plug from 8622 to 8522.
2. Set 35 sack cement plug from 6587 to 6687.
3. Set 35 sack cement plug from 5056 to 5156.
4. Set 35 sack cement plug from 2806 to 2906.
5. Set 35 sack cement plug from 1962 to 2062.

November 13, 1965 - Ran 1817' of 4 1/2" OD 8rd. 9.39 J-35 casing. Set @ 1817' and cemented
with 150 sz. regular neat cement. Plug down @ 11:00 a.m. 11-13-65. Perforated
1664-66, 1660-62, 1656-58, 1650-52, 1624-34 with 2 holes per foot. Acidified with
1500 gal. Mud Acid and 30 ball casings. Sub load acid and formation water. Well
produced water with some oil.

November 18, 1965 - Cut 4 1/2" casing at top of cement and pulled. Recovered 1480' of
4 1/2" casing.

November 19, 1965 - Finished plugging through tubing as follows:

1. Set 35 sack cement plug from 1395 to 1531.
2. Set 35 sack cement plug from 940 to 1050.
3. Set 10 sack cement surface plug from 0 to 25'.
4. Erected regulation marker & cleaned up location.

Location is now ready for final inspection.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
