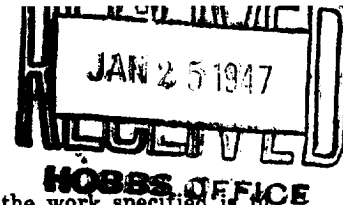

FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

We propose to temporarily stop production on this well in the shallow pay zones (1624' to 1635') to carry the well deeper. The present total depth is 3474 ft with 8 5/8" casing set at 935' and an uncased 8" hole below that point. Present 8" hole will be carried to about 3700' where we will set 7" casing to shut off water encountered from 3200' to 3400'. From that point a 7" hole will be carried. Plans are to make this a Clearfork Lime test.
