This well was drilled with cable tool and completed as follows:

4/1/67

Spudded and drilled to 376'. Set 374' of 8 5/8" OD 20# casing and cement with 50 sacks. Drilled to TD of 2614' and run 2614' of 4 1/2" OD 9.5# casing and cement with 150 sacks. Perforate with 1 shot per foot 2560-63 and 2570-79. Acidize well with 1000 gallons 15% acid then frac with 562 bbls. salt water and 20,000# of 20/40 sand. Clean out to 2612 and hook well up for injection.

Injection first five days averaged 500 BPD at 1150 PSI.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
