October 1, 1968 we ran 377' of 2 3/8" O.D. 20# casing, and cemented with 50 sacks of cement. On October 3rd the plug was drilled and water shut-off was found complete.

Nov. 15, 1968 we ran 2184' of 7" O.D. 20# casing with 197' of 4 1/2" 9.5# casing below the 7" casing and cemented with 150 sacks of cement. On Nov. 18th the plug was drilled and water shut-off was found complete. On November 18, 1968 the well was logged and the following zones perforated: 2382-40' with 5 holes, 2480-43' with 5 holes, 2644-54' with 5 holes.

On Nov. 19, 1968, the three zones in the well were acidized with 750 gallons and fractured with 27,360 gallons of water and 50,000 lbs. of sand.

The well was tested and the two upper zones are capable of making 20 BOPD and the lower zone will be added.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
