Cemented with 250 sacks Incon-Pozmix 2% gel at 10:30 p.m., August 12, 1970. Calculated top of cement behind 4 1/2 inch casing is 2,330 feet. Allowed cement to set 36 hours and tested casing with 1500 psi for 30 minutes with no pressure leak-off.

Instructions
