SUPPLEMENT TO THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

1. The Commission has the honor to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 10th day of January, 1942, in which you request that the Commission take action to prevent the exportation of oil and oil products from the United States to the Axis powers.

2. The Commission has considered your request and has determined that it is in the public interest to take such action as may be necessary to prevent the exportation of oil and oil products from the United States to the Axis powers.

3. The Commission has accordingly adopted the following resolution:

Resolved, That the Commission do hereby recommend to the War Relocation Authority that it take such action as may be necessary to prevent the exportation of oil and oil products from the United States to the Axis powers.
