On May 8, 1975 moved in Howard Boatright Co. rig. Ran tubing to PBTD of 2,220 ft. and circulated with 10# mud. Pulled tubing and set cast iron bridge plug at 2,100 ft. and dumped 3 sx cement in 4 1/2" csg. with bailer to 2,060 ft. shutting off casing perfs from 2,150 to 2,160 ft. Cut 4 1/2" casing at 1,700 feet and pulled casing leaving 2,263 4 1/2" casing in hole from 1,700 to 3,963 feet. Ran 2" tubing and set additional plugs as follows:
1,680' to 1,580' with 35 sx in 7 7/8" hole - base of salt.
756' to 656' with 35 sx in and out of 8 5/8" csg. 713 feet.
45' to surface with 15 sx in top of 8 5/8" casing.
Set 4 1/2" OD x 4' marker in top of casing. Notice will be sent as soon as location is prepared for final inspection.

Casing left in hole:

2,263' - 4 1/2" casing from 1,700 to 3,963'.

713' - 8 5/8" casing from surface to 713' w/cement circ.

Instructions

Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
