Drilled to total depth of 3550 feet in line with 7-7/8" hole at 10:00 a.m., January 11, 1971. Ran 107 jts. 4-1/2", 9.5#, J-55 casing, 3540 feet, set at 3550 feet. Cemented with 450 sacks Incor-Pozmix 2% gel at 7:00 p.m. Estimated top of cement behind 4-1/2" casing is 2000 feet. Allowed cement to set 60 hours and tested casing with 1500 psi for 30 minutes with no pressure leak-off, on January 11, 1971.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
