Cement is circulated behind 8-5/8" surface casing set at 694 feet. A 7-7/8" hole was drilled to total depth of 3647 feet with a rotary rig on February 27, 1971. Schlumberger logs were run indicating no possible oil productive zones.

It is proposed to plug and abandon the well using the rig on location by setting cement plugs with drill pipe as follows:

Plug from 3400' to 3300' w/40 sacks in open hole (Grayburg porosity)
Plug from 2800' to 2700' w/40 sacks in open hole (Top of Queen)
Plug from 1700' to 1600' w/40 sacks in open hole (Base of salt)
Plug from 750' to 650' w/40 sacks in & out of 8-5/8" surface casing.
Plug from 30' to surface w/10 sacks in top of 8-5/8" surface casing.

Work is expected to begin February 28, 1971.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
