On June 1, 1971, drilled 15" hole with rethole machine to 35'. Set 1 joint 12-3/4", 32# casing at 35' and cemented with 1 yard ready-mix. Moved in rotary rig and commenced drilling 11" hole at 5:00 p.m., June 2. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 657' at top of salt and drilled to 1,546'. Base of salt was 1,478'. Ran 16 joints 20#, 8-5/8" casing, 646', set at 657'. Cemented with 350 sacks Class C, 2% CaCl₂. Cement was in place at 7:30 a.m., June 5. Allowed cement to set 12 hours. Ripped up and tested casing with 800 psi for 30 minutes with no pressure leak-off. Drilled plug at 1:00 a.m., June 6, 1971.

It is proposed to drill this well to 3,700' in the San Andres formation instead of the 2,000', total depth, shown on our Form 9-331C. IF production is indicated, 1-1/2", 9-5/8" casing will be set at total depth and cemented with 250 sacks Incon-Powmix cement in the 7-7/8" drilled hole.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.
