Water leak appeared in cellar around wellhead in July, 1977. Tested pressure on bradenhead between 4-1/2" and 8-5/8" casings at 300 psi shut-in. Opened up bradenhead valve and pressure bled down to 0# producing small stream of muddy saltwater.

On August 1, 1977 rigged up pulling unit and pulled rods and tubing. Ran Halliburton retrievable bridge plug and set at 3100' in 4-1/2" casing, above top of perforations at 3194 feet. Tested 4-1/2" casing with 1400 psi - held o.k. Pulled tubing. Cemented behind 4-1/2" casing with 300 sacks Type H cement and 6# silsonite per sack plus 4% calcium chloride. Maximum pressure 400 psi. Shut-in overnight. Checked wellhead after 16 hours and no indication of water leak. Pulled bridge plug. Ran rods and tubing and returned to production August 3, 1977.

## Instructions
