On July 10, 1971 run drill pipe to 3564 feet and circulated hole with 10.2 lbs. per gal. drilling mud. Using Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Co. and Howco regular bulk cement, set plugs as follows using 10.2 lb. mud for displacement:

3564' to 3444' with 35 sacks - across San Andres porosity (7-7/8" hole)
3240' to 3120' with 35 sacks - across top of Grayburg (7-7/8" hole)
1543' to 1423' with 35 sacks - base of salt (7-7/8" hole)
708' to 588' with 35 sacks - in and out of 8-5/8" surface casing
30' to surface with 10 sacks - top of 8-5/8" surface casing.

Set 4-1/2" O.D. x 4' marker in top of casing. Notice will be sent as soon as location is cleared and ready for final inspection.

Casing left in hole:

661' - 8-5/8", 20# casing from surface to 661' with cement circulation.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include such special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
