Cement is circulated behind 8-5/8" surface casing set @ 661'. A 7-7/8" hole was drilled to total depth of 3564 feet with a rotary rig on July 9, 1971. Schlumberger logs were run indicating no possible productive zones.

It is proposed to plug and abandon the well using the rig on location by setting cement plugs with drill pipe as follows:

Plug from 3564' to 3444' with 35 sacks in open hole (San Andres porosity)
Plug from 3240' to 3120' with 35 sacks in open hole (Top of Grayburg)
Plug from 1543' to 1423' with 35 sacks in open hole (Base of Salt)
Plug from 708' to 588' with 35 sacks in and out of 8-5/8" surface casing
Plug from 30' to surface with 10 sacks in top of 8-5/8" surface casing.

Work is expected to begin July 10, 1971 using Halliburton Oil Well Cementing Co.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
