Gentlemen:

On behalf of our client, David Fasken, we request exemption from Rule 401 requiring a multi point back pressure test within 60 days after the initial connection. This request is due to the very marginal flowing status of the subject well. A copy of daily well head pressure and gas deliveries since going on stream February 7, 1972, is attached.

This well was completed on September 22, 1971, and after cleaning up 32,000 gals. of My-T-Frac with 78,000 pounds of 20-40 sand, the well had an absolute open flow potential of 3150 M.C.F. per day at 15.025 psig.
