We propose drilling the referenced well with rotary tools to a total depth of approximately 3900 feet or to a sufficient depth to test the Grayburg formation. Surface casing will be set in the top of the salt and cemented to surface. A salt protection casing will be run to approximately 1740' (100' below base of salt) and cemented with 50 sacks. If commercial production is encountered the free portion of the salt protection casing will be pulled and 5-1/2" casing will be ran to total depth and cemented with a sufficient amount of cement to circulate to surface. The well will then be stimulated as conditions indicate. (Casing requirements of R-111-A will be observed.

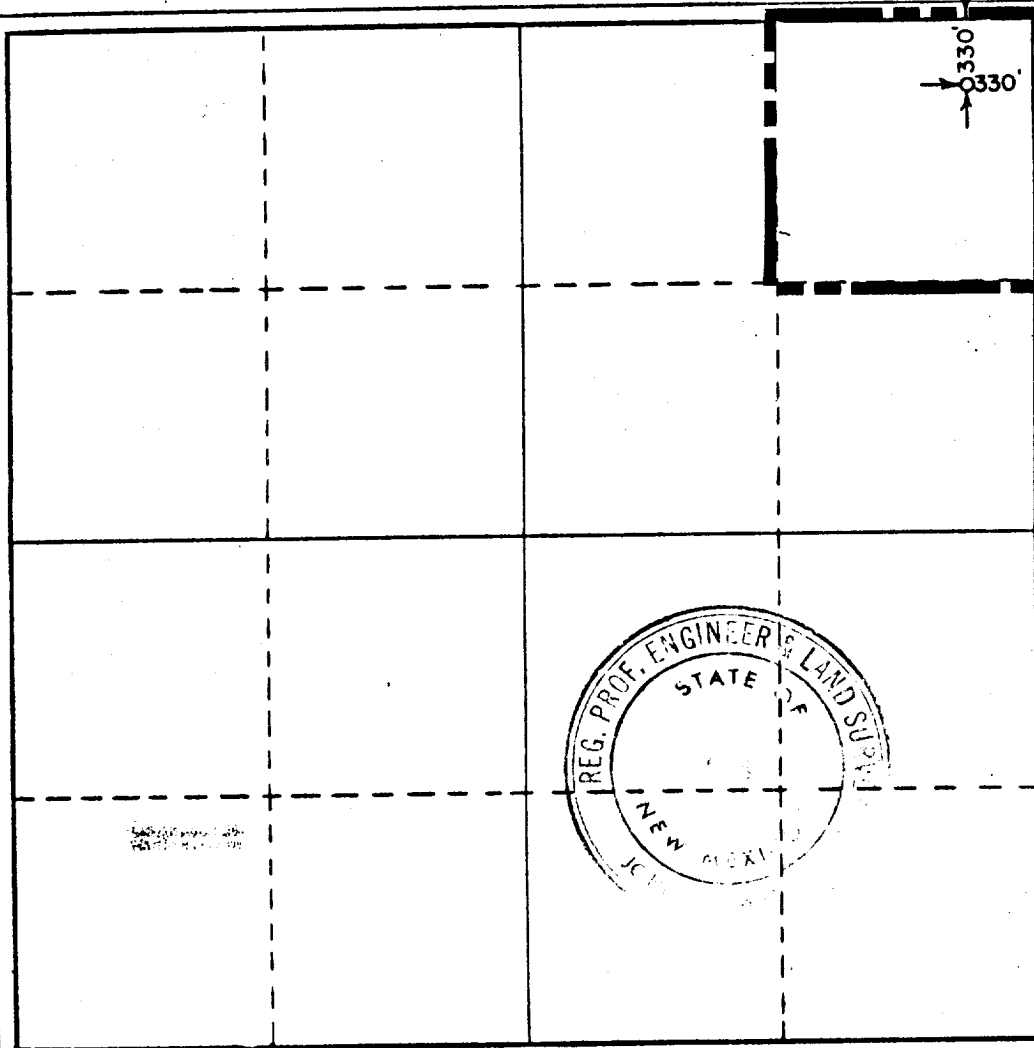


Please refer to Form No. 9-331C, dated October 12, 1971, relative to the captioned well.
