- Core #1: 3037' to 3099'. Recovered 61'. 3037-88, Tan sand; 3088-99', Red Sand; 3082-84', Oil bleeding shale, tight.
- Core #2: 3282' to 3333'. Recovered 49'. 3282-98' Dolomite, no show; 3298-3304', sand, good oil show; 3304-16', sand & dolomitic sand, no show; 3316-19', sand w/oil show; 3319-24', sand, no show; 3324-33', Dolomite, no show.
- Core #3: 3333' to 3378'. Recovered 42-1/2'. 3333-40', Dolomite, no show; 3340-52', sand, no show; 3352-61', Dolomite, no show; 3361-73', sand, oil show; 3373-78', Dolomite, no show.
