On July 6, 1973, 5½' casing was set in this well at 3518' with 250 sacks Class C cement. The top of cement behind the 5½' casing is at 2020'. The casing was perforated at 3162' - 3174' in the Loco Hills sand and at 3390' - 3394', 3446' - 3450', 3496' - 3500' in the Premier Sand. On about August 18, 1973, we plan to plug and abandon this well as per telephone conversation with Mr. Knauf.

Spot a 25 sack plug from 3500' to 3325' across the Premier perforation.
Spot a 25 sack plug from 3200' to 3025' across the Loco Hills perforations.
Spot a 25 sack plug in and out of 5½' casing at 2020' estimated free point.
Spot a 50 sack plug in and out base of 8-5/8" casing at 500'.
Place a 10 sack plug and marker at surface. The interval between the plugs will be filled with mud.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
