Ran 84 joints of 8-5/8" casing; 52 joints of 32 lb. K-55 ST&C, 2134.77 ft. and 32 joints of 24 lb. K-55 ST&C, 1476.22 ft.; total of 3610.99 ft., set at 3584 ft. Cemented with 850 sacks Howco Light with 5 lb. Gilsomite per sack and 1/4 lb. floreal per sack and 200 sacks Class C regular cement, cement did not circulate. Plug down at 2:00 P.M. Ran temperature survey. Top cement at 590 ft. Cemented outside 8-5/8" casing thru 1" pipe at 580 ft. with 400 sacks regular cement, cement did not circulate.

July 24, 1976 - Top of cement with 1" pipe 405 ft. Cemented with 150 sacks regular cement thru 1" pipe at 400 ft. Cement circulated at 5:30 A.M. Set slips on 8-5/8" casing. W.O.C. 8-5/8" casing total of 30 hours. Pressure tested blowout preventers and 8-5/8" casing 3,000 lb. pressure and drilling cement plug.

July 25, 1976 - Drilling 7-7/8" hole at 3760 ft. - 8:00 A.M.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations.
