5-27-77 Ran 69 joints of 8-5/8" casing, 21 joints of 32 lb. K-55 ST&C - 915.37 ft., 48 joints of 24 lb. K-55 ST&C - 2105.42 ft.; total of 3020.79 ft. Set at 3018 ft. Cemented with 800 sacks Howco light with 5 lb. Gilsomite per sack and 1/4 lb. Floseal, 200 sacks Class C, 2% calcium chloride. Cement did not circulate, plug down at 12:30 P.M. Ran Temperature Survey, top cement at 400 ft. Cemented outside 8-5/8" casing thru 1" pipe at 400 ft. with 200 sacks Class C, 2% calcium chloride. Cement circulated at 8:00 P.M. Set slips on 8-5/8" casing and W.O.C.

5-28-77 W.O.C. 8-5/8" total 24 hours. Pressure tested blowout preventors and 8-5/8" casing 3,000 lb. pressure. O.K. Drilling cement plug.

5-29-77 Drilling 7-7/8" hole at 3330 ft. at 8:00 A.M.

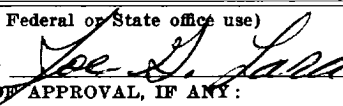
