- The geologic surface formation is Triassic redbeds with a coverage of Quaternary sand dunes.
- The estimated tops of important geologic markers are:
 - (a) anhydrite - 400'
 - (b) salt top - 600'
 - (c) salt base - 1600'
 - (d) Yates - 1750'
 - (e) Seven Rivers - 2100'
- The estimated depths for oil and gas production will be from 2100' to TD.
- The above casing program will be new casing.
- See reverse side for control equipment schematics.
- Will use approximately 500 bbls. total of 10.5# brine water from surface to TD.
- A sub will be on the floor @ all times w/full opening valve.
- A possibility of coring from 2100 to T.D. Decision to be made at a later date. Loggish will be CNL-IDC and DLL-RXO. Will run temperature survey to determine cement top below 5 1/2 casing.
- No abnormal pressures or temperatures or H2S gas expected.
- Anticipate starting in latter half of 3rd quarter 1977 w/a duration of 5 days.

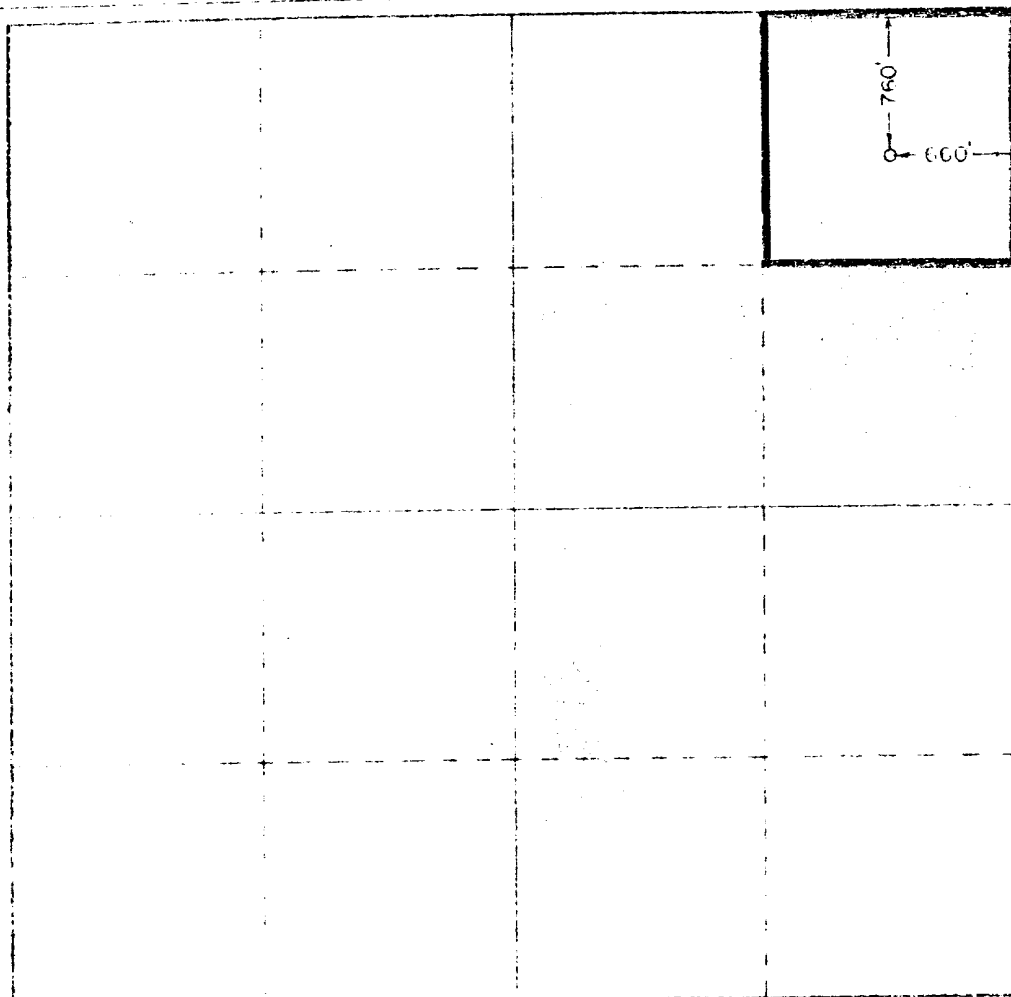

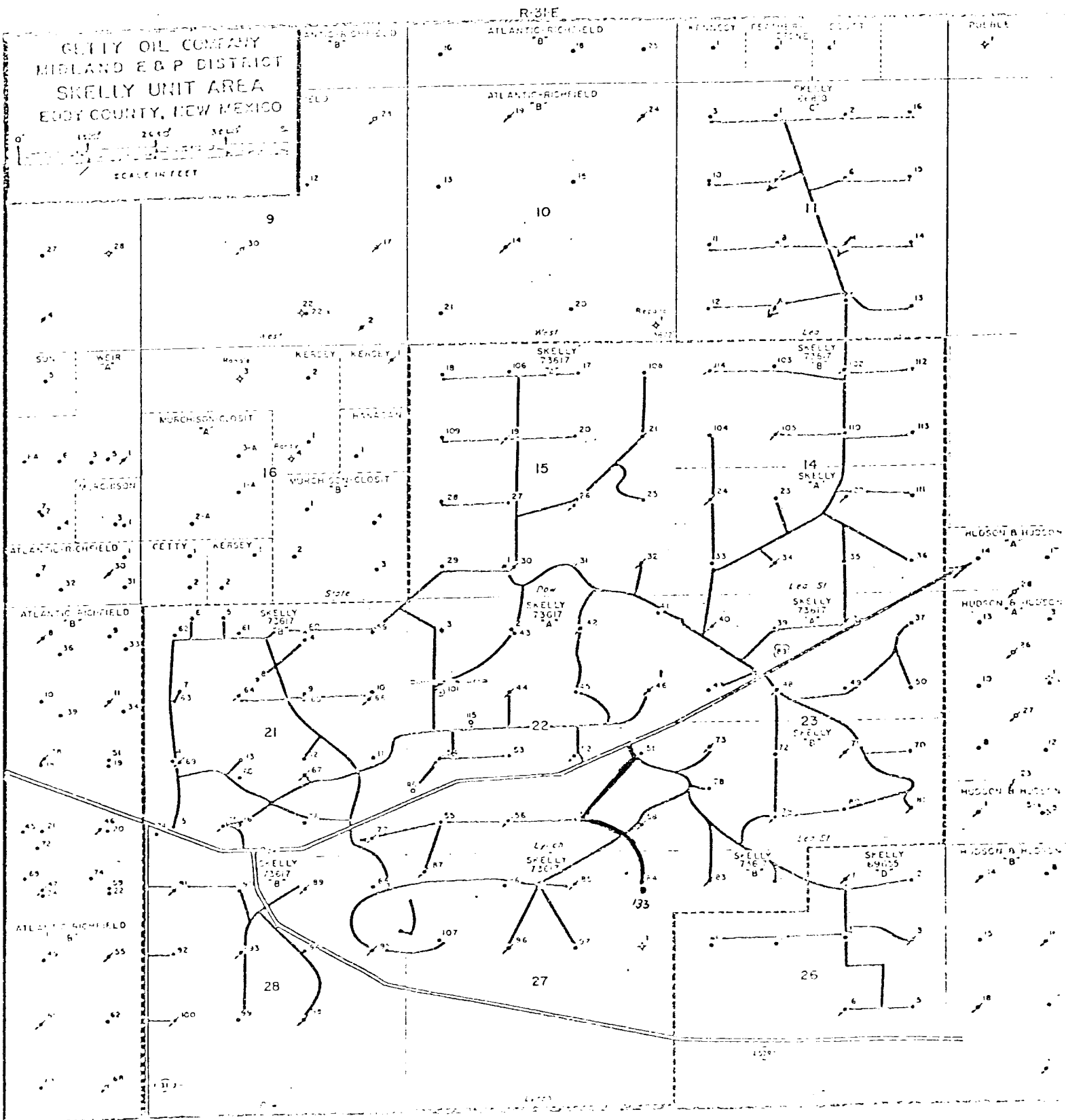
